

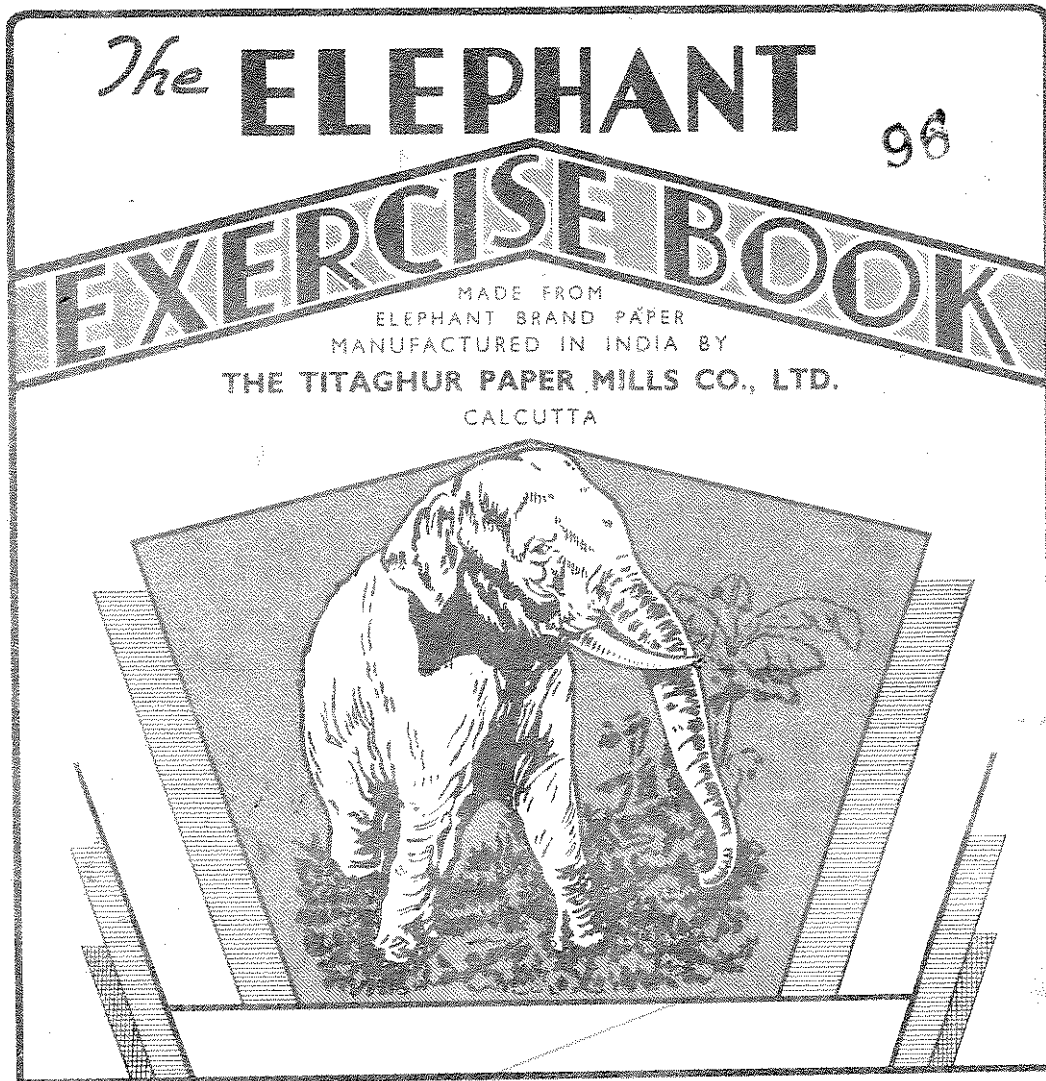

Book one, page one of records created by Sharif Hazarika in his handwriting:

ALI AHMED HAZARIKA alias THOLEK HAZARIKA WAS BORN AT SANKHAT in 1787 and died at Jorhat in 1860.

ALI AHMED HAZARIKA probably got his name Tholek ~~fr~~ from the ASSAM Kings household where he was a constant visitor. He migrated to Jorhat in 1830 and lived in a house on his own land on the present No Ali. The house was about 300 yards away from the present DOSS & Co., Jorhat.

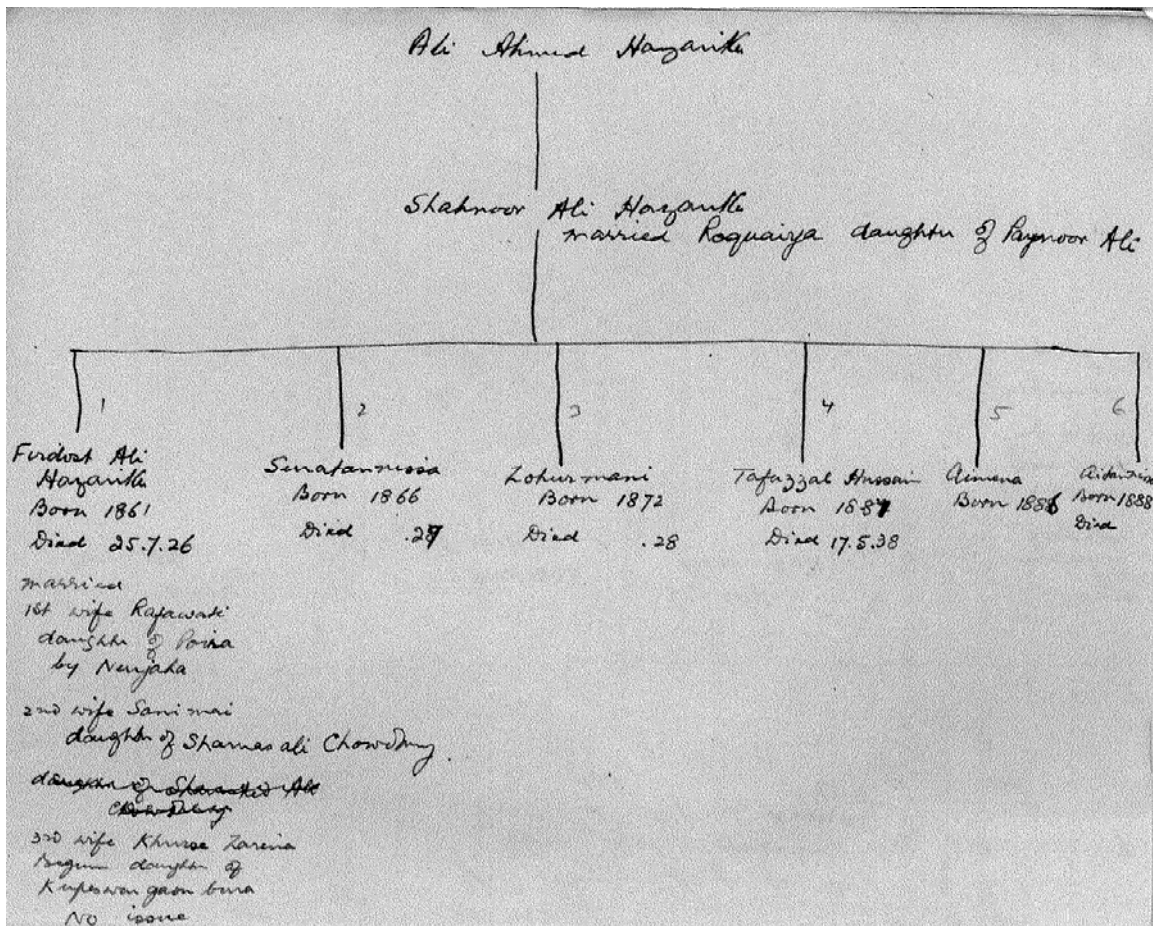
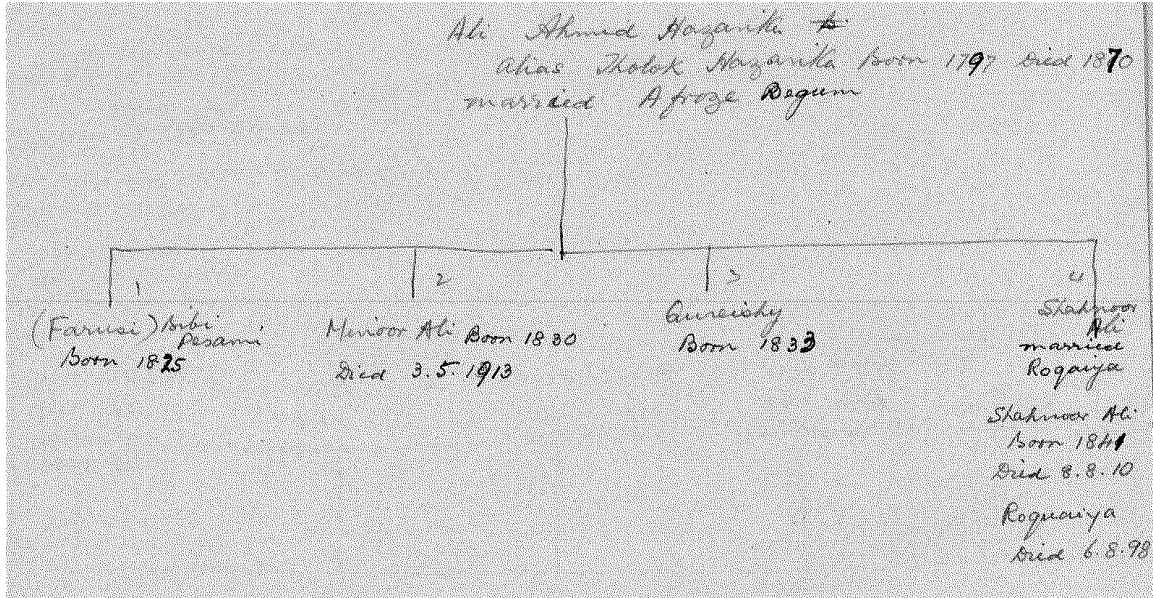
ALI AHMED HAZARIKA married ~~Mijet~~ AFROZE who died in the year 1896. There is no record as to who Afroze was, ~~and~~ Shahnoor Ali Hazarika her youngest son kept the above in complete record. Shahnoor Ali Hazarika's daughter Amena who is still alive remembers seeing her grand mother who was then very old, but still a ~~very~~ beautiful woman mostly sitting on a "Chaman pira" and passing her days.

Shahnoor Ali Hazarika along with his eldest brother Minoor Ali Hazarika migrated to Titabar in 1885 after selling their house at Jorhat. Between them they possessed more land property at Titabar than at Jorhat. Later on Minoor

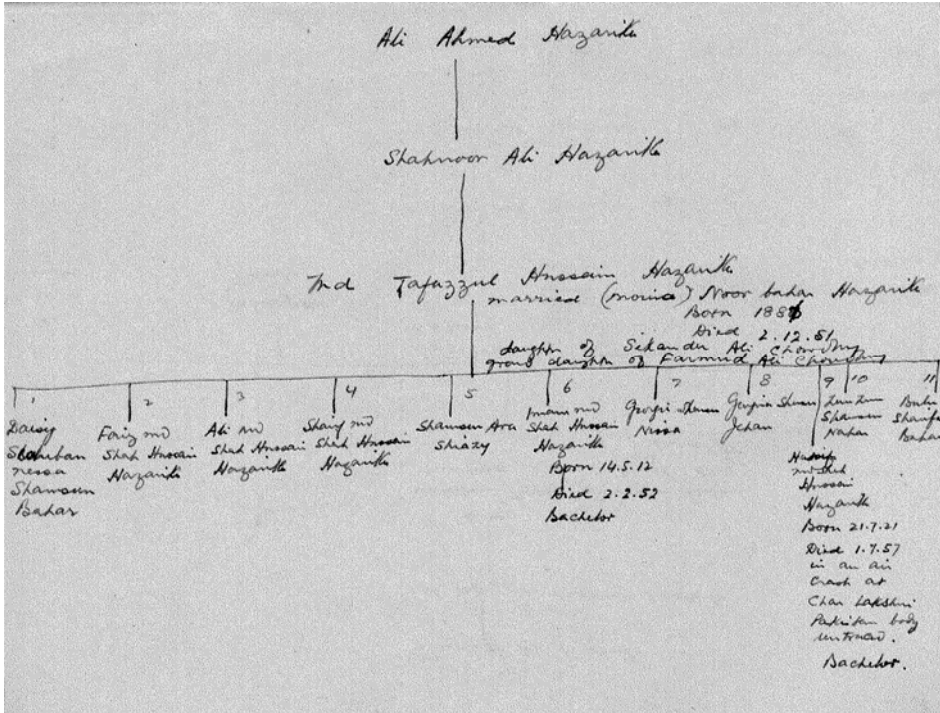
Ali Hargilla migrated to Heelakha and again acquired some property at Joshat. Sub-
 now Ali Hargilla lived at Titabar Charahi
 first and after changing his residence ~~there~~
 thrice, first to a house near the Titabar bazar
 then to a house near the place where he
 was later buried, again to a house
 near the gate of the present Madigan house.
 Finally in 1893 he shifted to the house
 which is even now occupied by his eleven
 grand-children.

As no one remembers about Ali Ahmad
 Hargilla's fore fathers I am ignoring records
 on this account. These records ~~were~~ were
 not properly made nor authenticated. What
 I am recording may be verified by many
 old people who are still alive.

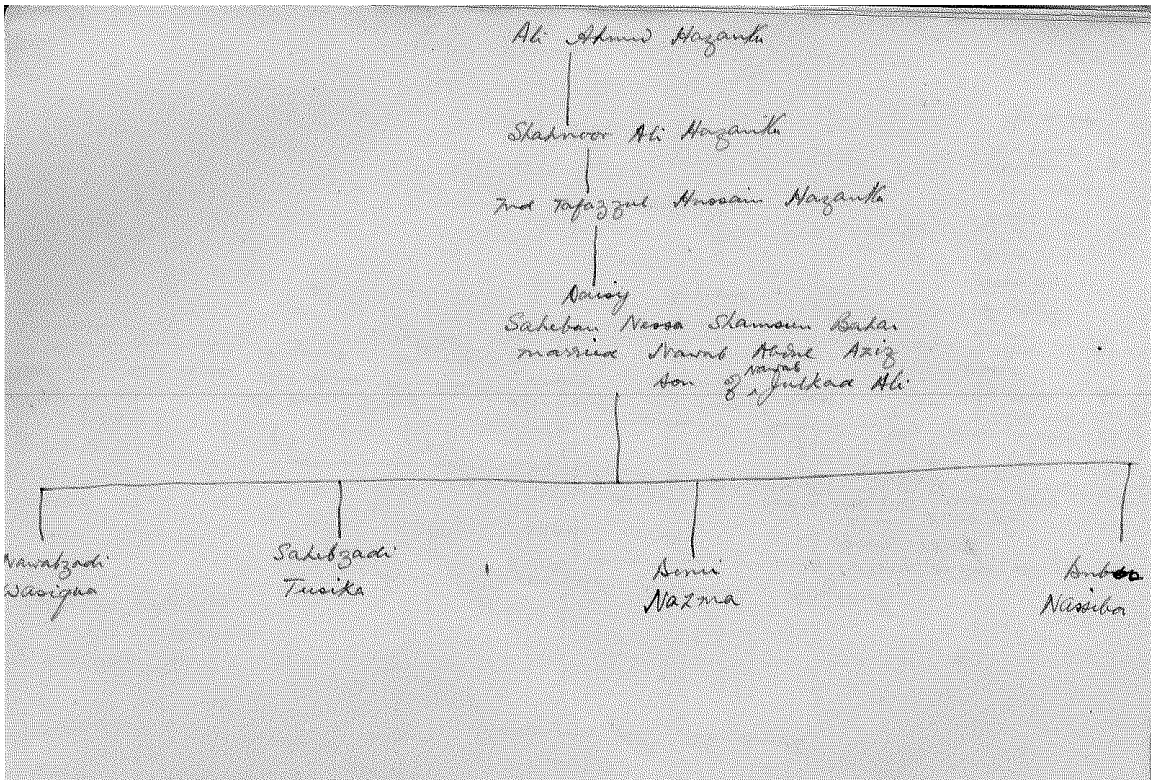
It is surprising how in a matter

 so many hundreds of descendants.



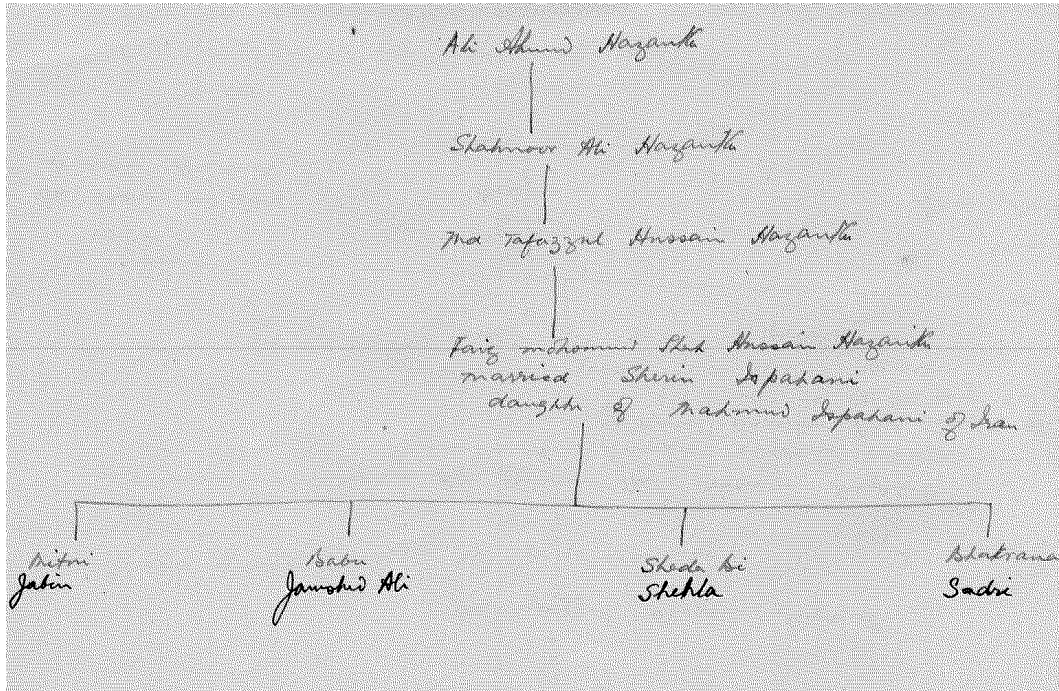

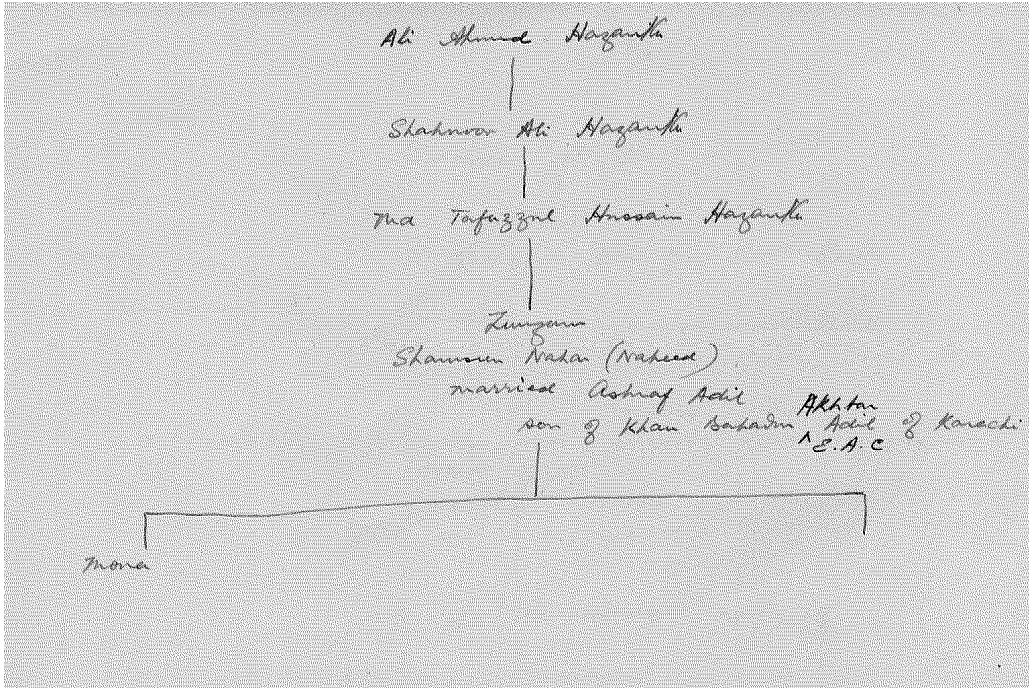

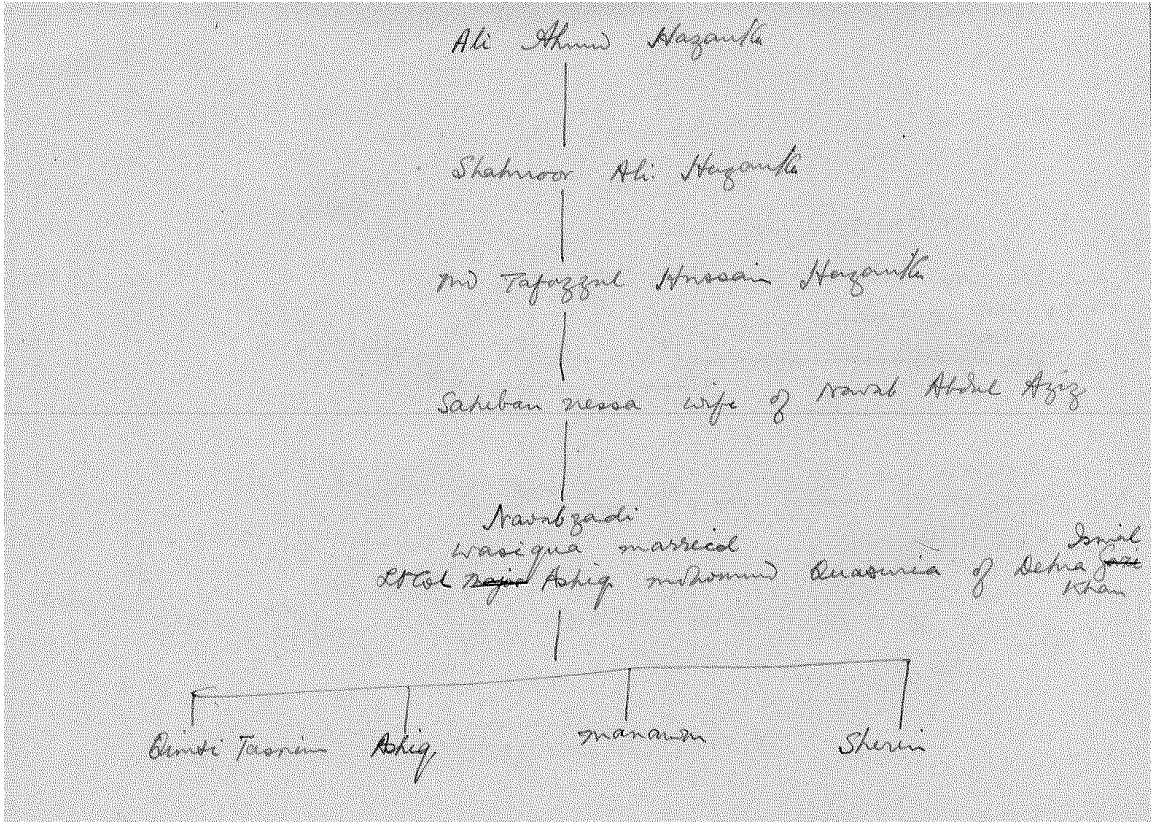
